TRANSFER AIRPORT – HOTEL

- Bus to City Air Terminal (Vienna Hilton) EUR 6.00 (every 20 min)
- Taxi downtown: You can book in advance under the following number: +43/1/7007-33833 (Airport Services). We arranged a taxi transportation at a special rate of EUR 29.07 + 10% = EUR 32.00 from the airport to anywhere in Vienna. Please refer to bpv HÜgel's arrangement to get this special rate, which has to be remitted directly to the driver.
- CAT – City Airport Train
At City Air Terminal Wien-Mitte, at the corner of "Invalidenstraße/Marxergasse", 1030 Vienna, Trains depart every 8 and 38 minutes after the hour (from 5.38 a.m. to 11.08 p.m.). Single Ticket € 9, 00 or Return Ticket € 16,00.
